Use of NZTA DL9 Medical Certificates — by Student Pilots and Recreational Pilot Licence holders.

Sections of the DL9 to be checked

We have used the generic DL9 form that is provided by the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) as an example, a computer generated format is also acceptable.

Applicant's Signature

The student or RPL holder needs to have signed and dated the certificate below.

Important information for applicant	Applicant's statement
<p>You should note that the Land Transport (Driver Licensing) Rule 1999 requires the collection of the information you provide on this form, in order to determine your medical fitness to drive. The information is collected and held by the NZ Transport Agency. You are entitled to access, and request the correction of, any readily retrievable information held about you by the Transport Agency.</p> <p>Information relating to driver licence status, but not your medical certificate or any details of any medical conditions that you may have, may be released under the Land Transport Act 1998.</p> <p>It is an offence to supply false information and may lead to your application being delayed or declined.</p>	<p>I have presented myself to the doctor named on this certificate for examination for fitness to drive. Note: Having the passenger endorsement on the DL9 does not have anything to do with carrying passengers for aviation purposes; it is purely a requirement for the medical certificate as stated in Civil Aviation Rule 61.355(a)(2).

Note: If a student or RPL holder is going to be flying in controlled airspace they will require to have passed an Ishihara colour vision test and have proof of such.
