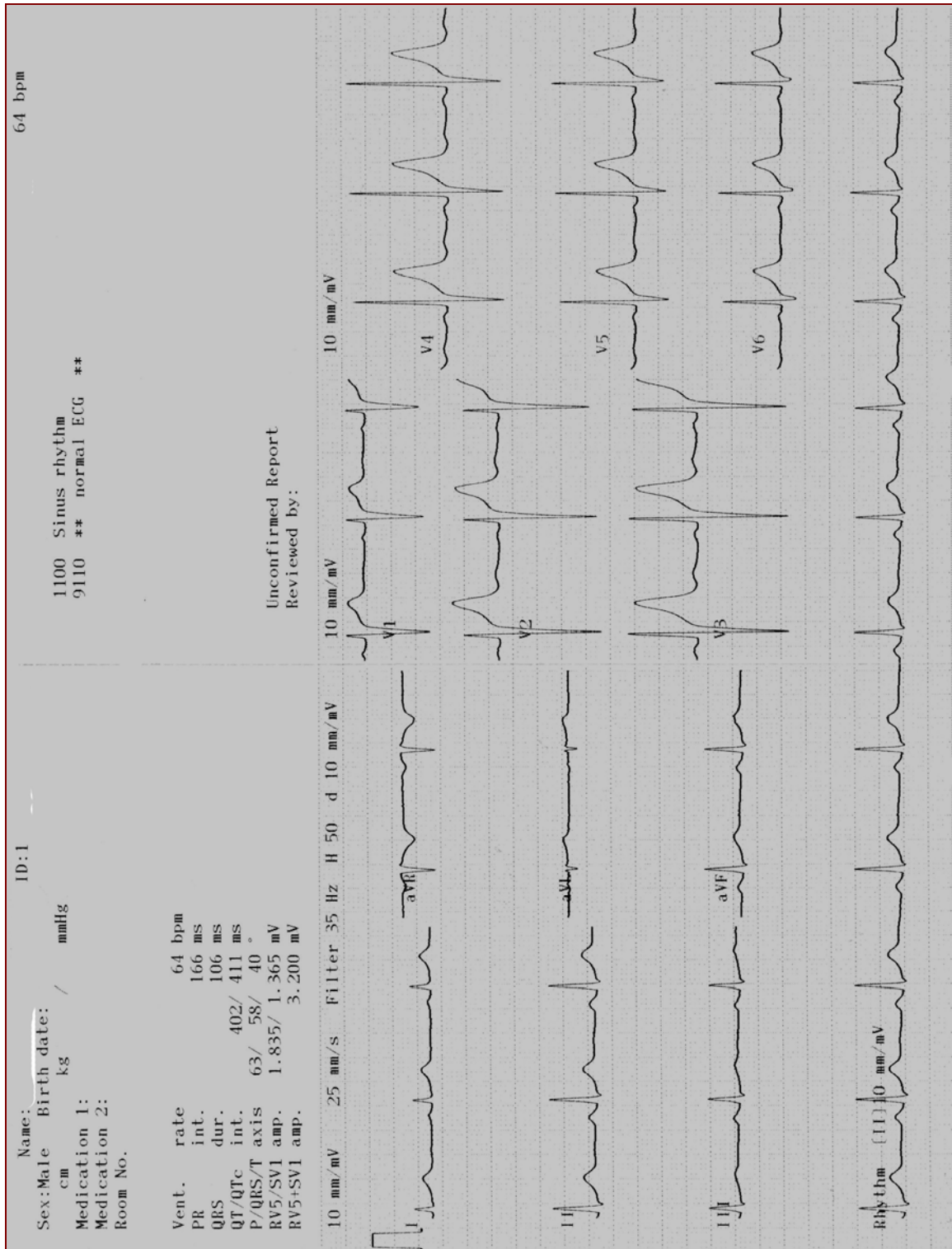

01 October 2006 (Current ECG)

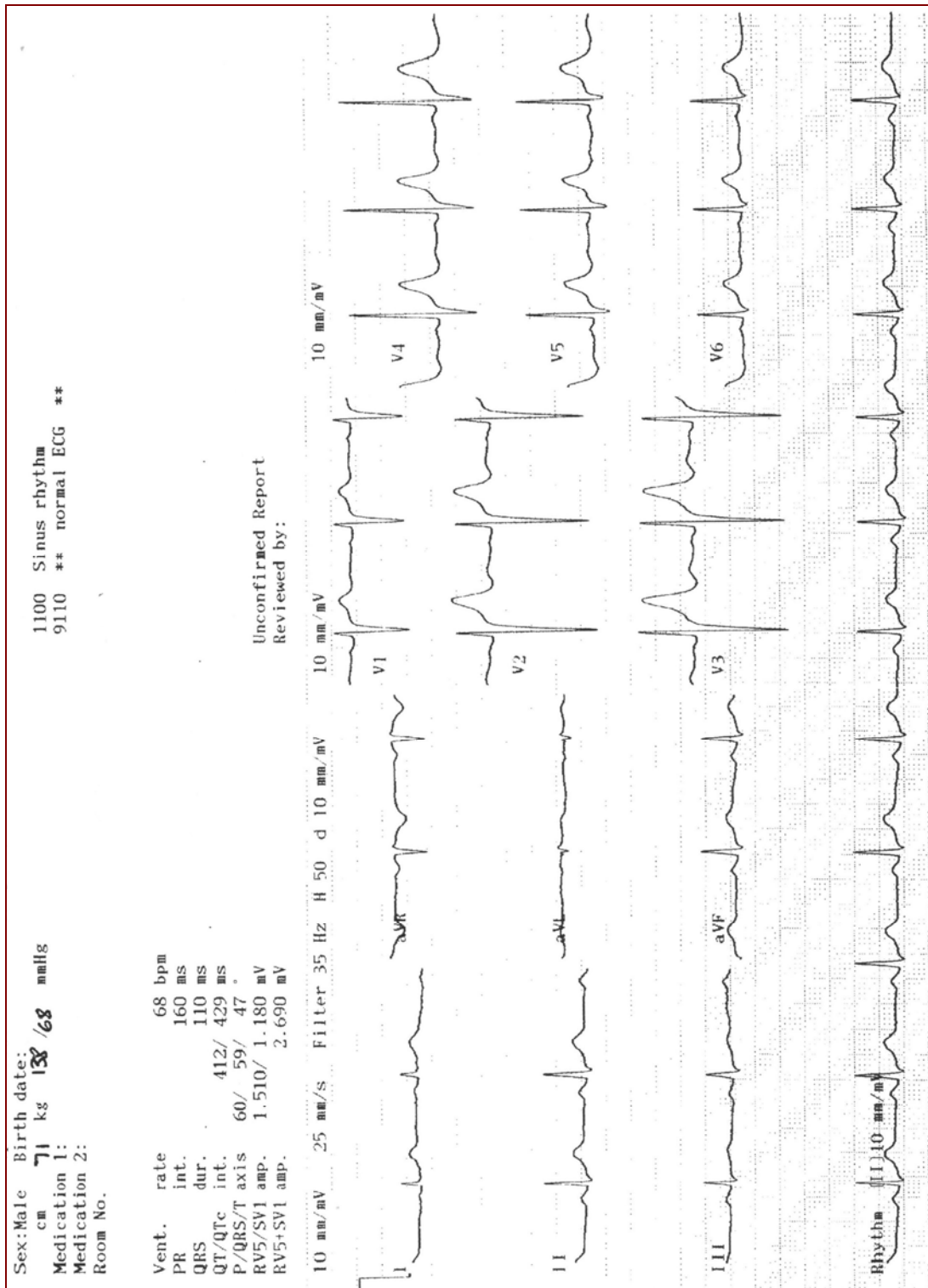


56 year old male, class 1 medical certificate applicant with calculated 5 – 10% 5-year cardiovascular risk.

01 October 2005 (One year ago)

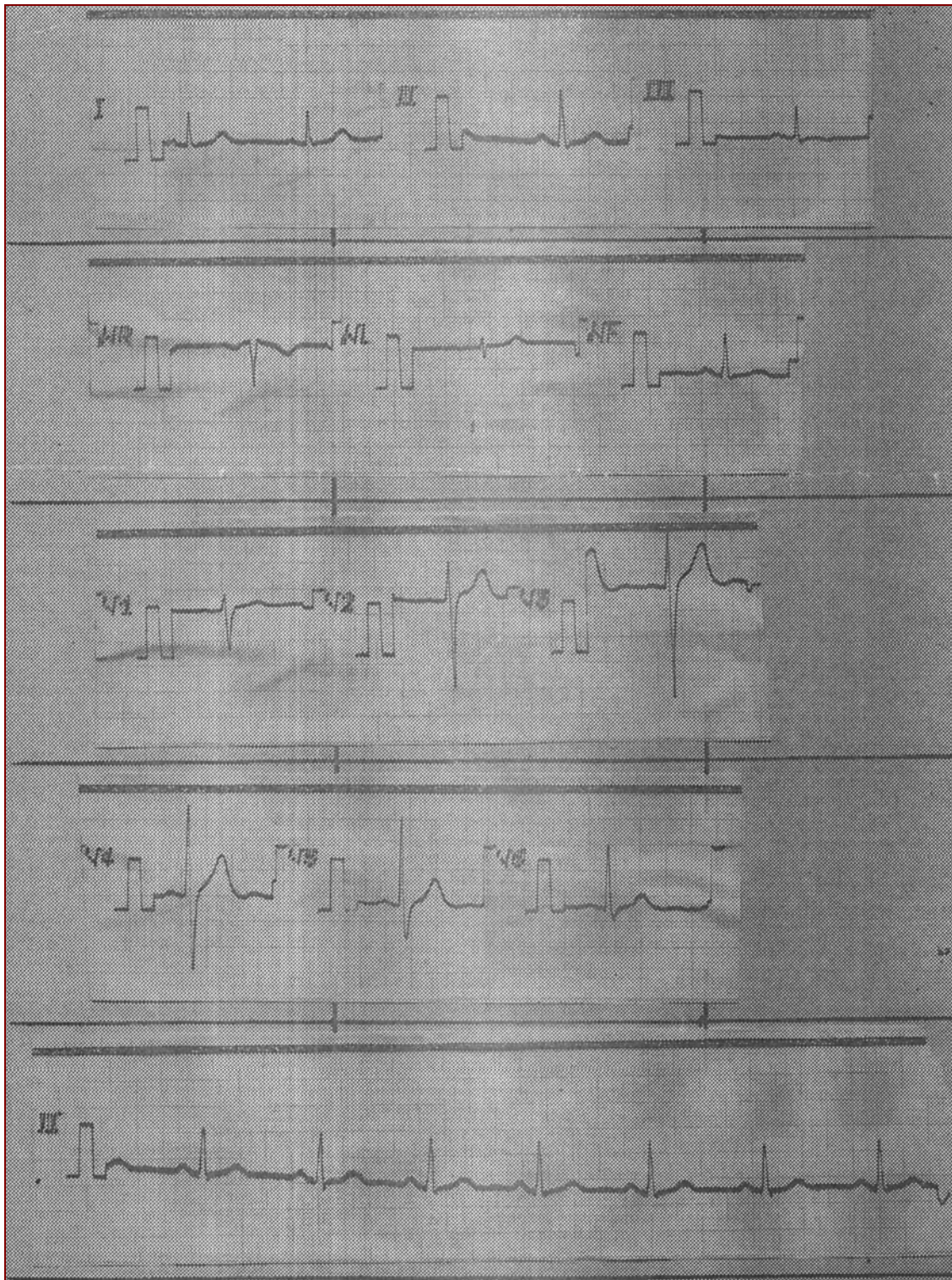


55 year old male, class 1 medical certificate applicant. Issued unrestricted class 1 medical certificate.

01 October 2004 (Two years ago)

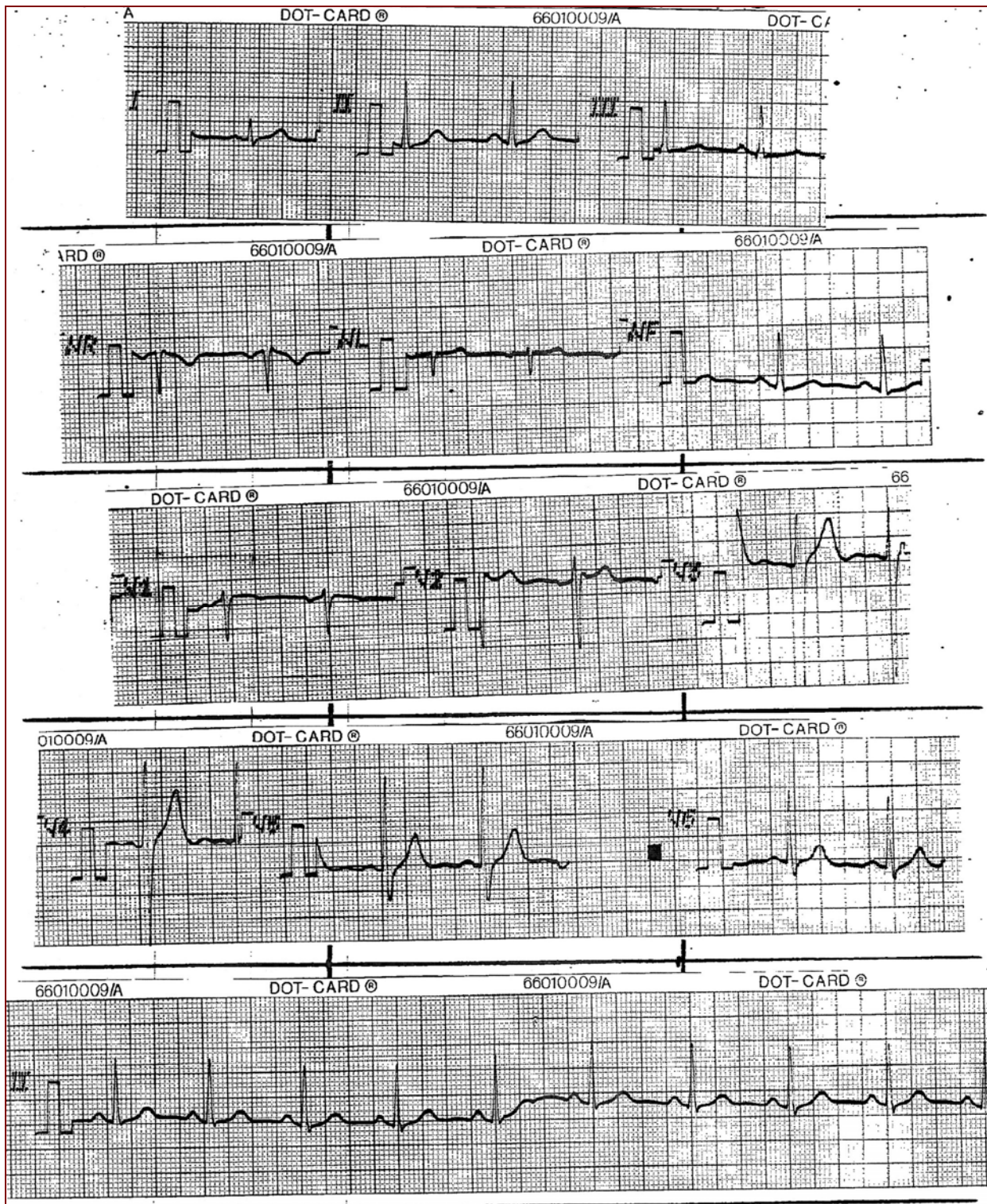


54 year old male, class 1 medical certificate applicant. Issued unrestricted class 1 medical certificate.

01 October 2003 (Three years ago)

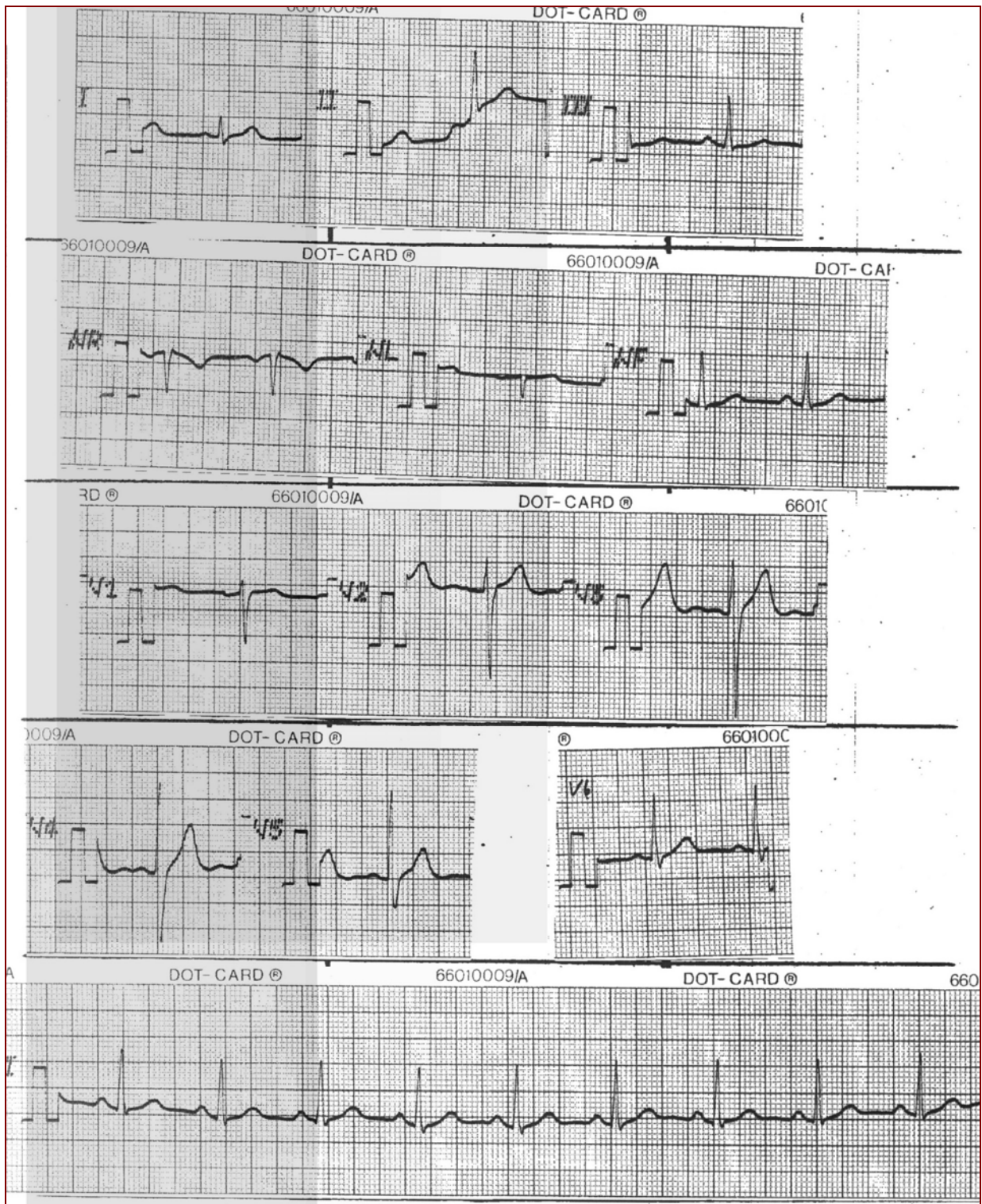


53 year old male, class 1 medical certificate applicant. Issued unrestricted class 1 medical certificate.

01 October 2002 (Four years ago)

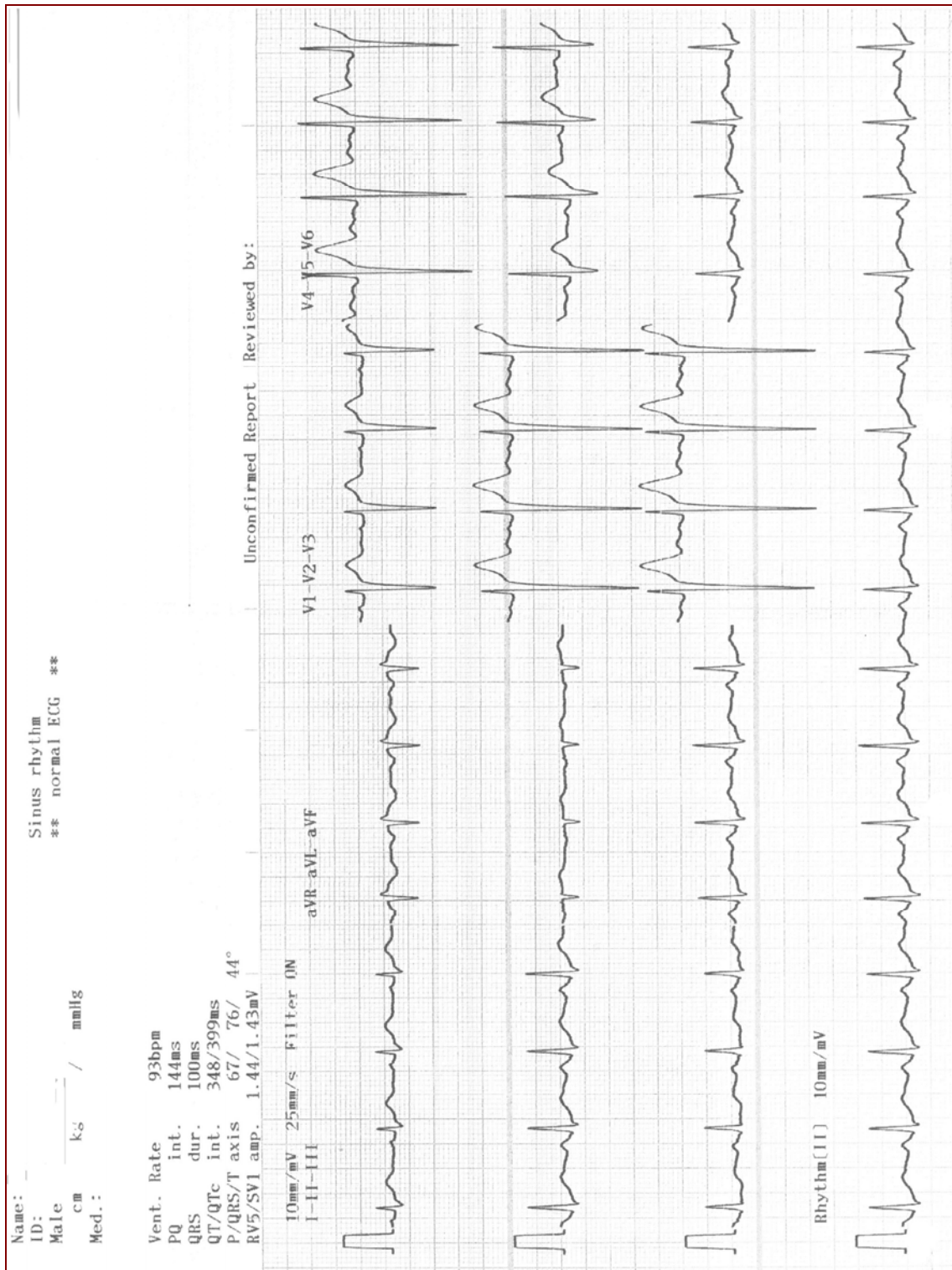


52 year old male, class 1 medical certificate applicant. Issued unrestricted class 1 medical certificate.
