Civil Aviation Rules
Part 91, Amendment 24
General Operating and Flight Rules
Docket 15/CAR/1

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Rule objective

The objective of amendment 24 to Part 91 is to provide necessary consequential changes to support the amendment of Part 101 and the creation of Part 102.

Extent of consultation

A Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, NPRM 14-01, containing the proposed Part 91 was issued for public consultation under Docket 15/CAR/1 on 4 December 2014.

The publication of this NPRM was notified in the Gazette on 4 December 2014 and advertised in the daily newspapers in Auckland, Hamilton, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin on 5 December 2014. The NPRM was published on the CAA web site and a notice of publication was sent to 2364 identified stakeholders including representative organisations who were considered likely to have an interest in the proposal.

A period of 57 days was allowed for comment on the proposed rule.

Summary of submissions

86 written submissions were received on the NPRM.

A full CAA response to the themes that emerged during the submissions process and a table documenting all of the changes made to the final rule during the NPRM and consultation period is available on the CAA's website.

Examination of submissions

Submissions may be examined by application to the Docket Clerk at the Civil Aviation Authority between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm on weekdays, except statutory holidays.

Amendments

This rule amends Part 91 General Operating and Flight Rules by amending rule 91.1.

Effective date of rule

Amendment 24 to Part 91 comes into force on 1 August 2015.

Part 91 General Operating and Flight Rules Amendment 24

1 Rule 91.1 Purpose

After rule 91.1(c)(2), insert:

“(2A) a person operating an aircraft under the authority of an unmanned aircraft operator certificate granted under the Act and in accordance with Part 102 unless compliance with any of the requirements in this Part is required as a condition of operation; and”.
